except a pox on the ear!

Last Mon. we went for a ride
in the morning, took the gees
on Sandhills - as good as a
switchback (see sketches) it's as
much as you do to keep from
slipping backwards over the horses
tails one minute & vice versa
the next. awfully beastly lark
don't know our yes boy gave
rather! etc. I have started

modeling a trotting in the red
wax in fact it is quite $\frac{2}{3}$ done
